Full Professor in the Department of Mathematical Analysis of the University Complutense of Madrid since 1974 (first, "Profesor Agregado", 1974-1981; then "Catedrático de Universidad", 1981-2014). Emeritus Professor of the University Complutense of Madrid since 2014 till now.

Main researcher of 8 projects supported by the Ministry of Education and member of several other national and international research projects.

Author of more than one hundred papers and several books. He has been advisor of 13 PhD.

Visiting professor in several research centers in Great Britain, U.S.A., Germany, Cuba, Mexico, Poland, etc. and plenary speaker in many international meetings in functional analysis.
