Abbreviated curriculum

Graduate in Physical Sciences from the University of Madrid (1960) and Ph.D. in Mathematics from the University of Barcelona with Extraordinary Doctoral Award (1967). He has been Assistant Professor at the University of Carabobo (Venezuela) (1961-1963), Assistant Professor at the University of Barcelona and at the ETS of Architecture of Barcelona (1964-69). He was *Profesor Agregado* at the Complutense University of Madrid (1969-71) and Full Professor at the University of Salamanca (1971-2008), in which he was Director of the Mathematical Seminar (CSIC) (1977-84) and Dean of the Faculty of Sciences (1990 - 96). Since 2008, he is Emeritus Professor at the University of Salamanca and a member of the Research Institute on Physics and Mathematics of the University of Salamanca.

His research has centered on the Differential Geometry and its applications to Geometric Mechanics, Mathematical Physics and Theoretical Physics, topics on which has published more than 50 papers. Main researcher in 14 funded research projects, he has been invited lecturer in many International Conferences, highlighting their membership to the Scientific Committees for more than 20 annual congresses on "Differential Geometrical Methods in Mathematical Physics", held at different European universities and published in the Lect. Not. in Math., of Springer, (two of them held in Salamanca: volumes 836 (1980) and 1251 (1987), of which he was Editor). Likewise, he was organizer in Salamanca of the International Conference "New Applications of Multisymplectic Field Theory" (1999) and the "Third Iberoamerican Conference on Geometry, Mechanics and Control" (2012). Advisor of several doctoral thesis, and evaluator for numerous scientific papers and research projects, he has been visiting professor at the universities of Coimbra (Portugal), Torino and Florence (Italy), Carabobo, Simón Bolívar, Puerto Rico, Autónoma de México, Venezuelan Institute of Scientific Researches and the International Centre for Theoretical Physics of Trieste (Italy). He has belonged or belongs to the Editorial Board of several international mathematical journals, of which include the "Revista Matemática Iberoamericana" and the "Journal of Geometry and Physics", which has been a founding member.

He has been President of the Spanish Royal Mathematical Society (1982-88), President of the Spanish Confederation of Centers of Mathematical and Statistics Research (CSIC) (1984-1989), Corresponding Member of the Spanish Royal Academy of Sciences (1988-2008), Director of the ETS of Telecommunications of the Polytechnic University of Cartagena (1998-2000). Likewise, he has been Director of the Chair "Almirante Martín Gramizo" (CESEDEN) (1994-98) and member of the Academic Councils of the Police Academy of Ávila and Civil Aviation Studies at Salamanca (1990-96). Award 1977 of the Spanish Royal Academy of Sciences, and member of Honor of the Spanish Royal Mathematical Society (2015), he is in possession of the "Víctor de Bronce" to the Professional Merit, the Medal of the Order of Andrés Bello of the Republic of Venezuela and the Spanish Naval, Military and Police Merit Crosses.
